Issues Common to All Versions of Chrome	<p>An error message similar to the following is displayed when attempting to open a file: Function 'onReadyState' Error: Access to 'file:///file_path/ file_name' from script denied</p> <p>Due to restrictions inherent in the Chrome and Firefox browsers, you cannot use ViewContentURL to open a file on a local file system.</p> <p>Work-Around Use the Edge, Internet Explorer, or Safari browsers to open the file instead.</p>
Issues Common to All Versions of Chrome	<p>The Chrome browser crashes when a large XML file representing the HTML page is returned by the system.</p> <p>A PeopleSoft application can return a large XML file representing the HTML page in many scenarios including the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The data set includes a large number of rows. • The data includes a very large image. • The data includes multiple images per row. <p>Work-Around There is no work-around.</p>
Issues Common to All Versions of Chrome	<p>File attachments, such as PDF reports, downloaded from a PeopleSoft system are not automatically opened and displayed.</p> <p>Work-Around Go to the Download folder on the device and manually open the downloaded file.</p>
