

## Enrolling in CSU FULLY ONLINE Courses

CSUSM returning students: You may be eligible to take a CSU Fully Online course from one of the other 22 CSU campuses while you're enrolled in courses at CSUSM!

If you are an F-1 visa international student please check in with the global education office first before enrolling in any online courses to determine if you are eligible to do so.

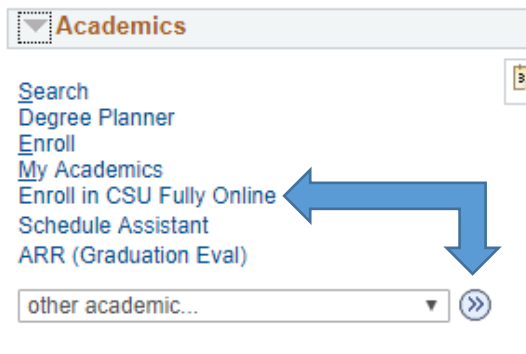
### To participate in CSU Fully Online, undergraduates must have:

- ✓ Completed at least one term at Cal State San Marcos and earned at least 12 units as a matriculated student\*.
- ✓ Attained a grade point average of 2.0 in all work completed at Cal State San Marcos and is in good standing.
- ✓ Enrolled at Cal State San Marcos during the period of concurrent enrollment.
- ✓ Paid tuition and fees as a full-time student (6.1 or more units).

*\*New transfer students may enroll in classes their first term, as long as they are enrolled and pay tuition and fees as a full time student.*

## Enrolling in CSU FULLY ONLINE Courses

By choosing your campus (CSUSM) a list of eligible CSU semester campuses will appear. You won't see CSUSM courses because as a reminder the CSU FULLY ONLINE program is allowing you to take other CSU online courses that will automatically transfer back to your CSUSM records.

### CSU FULLY ONLINE

If you're a CSU student, you can take **one free online course** every term (semester or quarter) through any of the CSU's 23 campuses. A "fully online" course is any class that's offered completely online, meaning there's no face-to-face instruction with a professor.

#### What is a Fully Online course?

Fully Online courses are online classes hosted across the CSU system by various campuses that allow CSU students the opportunity to remotely take 1 free online course per term for credit at their home campus. Students must meet all eligibility criteria to participate.

**Example scenario:** A student attends San Diego State University. If eligible, the student may take a fully online course hosted by CSU Chico for credit at the home campus (San Diego State University).

**Why?** The California State University wants to give students access to online courses offered in a variety of disciplines from each of the 23 system campuses with the goal of expanding enrollment opportunities.

#### You're Eligible for CSU Fully Online If:

- ✓ You've completed at least one term at a CSU campus as a matriculated student and earned at least 12 units at that campus.
- ✓ Your GPA is at least 2.0 at your campus and you are in good standing.
- ✓ You are or will be enrolled at your campus during the time you're taking a fully online class through another CSU campus.
- ✓ You've paid all your tuition as a full-time student.

You'll now be able to search the data base for CSU FULLY Online courses:

Note: Courses listed with attributes of:

- **\*Upper Division** CSU GE AREA (General Education Area) "UD-B" may be used to meet CSUSM's Upper Division General Education area BB
- **\*Upper Division** CSU GE AREA (General Education Area) "UD-C" may be used to meet CSUSM's Upper Division General Education area CC
- **\*Upper Division** CSU GE AREA (General Education Area) "UD-D" may be used to meet CSUSM's Upper Division General Education area DD

\*You may wish to verify your Upper Division General Education choice with your advisor since certain restrictions might exist depending on your major. You may use the following link: [eAdvisor](#)

- **Lower Division General Education** courses listed with attributes of: A1, A2, A3, B, C1, C2, D, E will be honored should you still need any of these. Consult your Academic Requirement Report (Faculty approval not required)
- **Just need units to meet minimum graduation requirements:** These courses are all fully transferable, just be sure you're not taking a course you've already completed at CSUSM. Remember these courses are listed as Lower Division and Upper Division. If you need Upper

Division units make sure you're choosing appropriately. (Faculty Approval not required if you are just taking the course to earn units and not a specific major requirement/major elective.

- Trying to meet a major requirement or major elective requirement?** This will require work on your part. Once you've found a course(s) that sounds like it may work for a major requirement or major elective: You'll want to click on the specific course which will give you a course description. You'll need to run this by your faculty advisor and/or major department. Let them know that you would like to know if they would approve the CSU Fully Online course for use in your major and be specific in terms of what requirement you'd like to try and use this for. If they approve this you would then finish the enrollment process. They would need to also submit an Alternative Course Approval into the data base so once the grade comes in it can be posted to your record. Need contact information? ## Fully Online Courses Transferable for Credit

*Am I eligible to participate?*

The following online courses will transfer for credit to **CHICO STATE** as a General Education (GE) requirement, specific course fulfillment, or an elective.

*Note: Even if the "CSU GE Area" or "Course EQ/GE Area" columns are empty, you may still receive GE or course-to-course credit. Please contact the Registrar's Office at your campus to verify how a course will transfer.*

# Enrolling in CSU FULLY ONLINE Courses

## How to enroll:

- Click on the specific course you're interested in enrolling into:

Pay close attention to details like:

- Host campus, Course Name, Course Number. You'll be able to use the search button later, but you'll need to know this information to easily locate the course again.
- Attributes (if it meets a General Education Area)
- Start Date
- Enrollment period (once enrollment period is over you won't be able to enroll in that course)
- Prerequisites/Corequisite info
- Campus Welcome pdf document
- Now Click on the **Visit Student Portal to request Enrollment** button so that your request can be processed. NOTE: This will bring you back to your Student Center where you'll once again select: Enroll in CSU Fully Online
