General Issues Associated with Microsoft Internet Explorer	<p><i>Bug 19263018</i> On a Windows tablet, you are unable to swipe left or right—for example, to navigate to other fluid homepages.</p> <p>Windows tablets do not support some standard touch events such as swiping.</p> <p>Work-Around Use the mouse and the drop-down list to navigate to other fluid homepages.</p>
General Issues Associated with Microsoft Internet Explorer	<p>Loss of update, display of search page while clicking quickly on a PeopleSoft page.</p> <p>In some situations when users are clicking quickly on a page, Internet Explorer will close the socket for the previous request when the next request comes in, but before the previous request's response is returned to the browser. This can cause the loss of update or the search page to be displayed.</p> <p>Work-Around Users should wait for the page to finish loading after every action.</p>
General Issues Associated with Microsoft Internet Explorer	<p>Pressing CTRL+J does not show the System Information page.</p> <p>Work-Around Press SHIFT+CTRL+J to display the System Information page.</p>
