Double-count units for GE		Major courses and campus-wide courses approved for GE shall double count for GE requirements.	Fall 2018

- The changes described above are applied cumulatively (i.e. all requirements in Fall 2016, are also in Fall 2018, and so on); therefore, students electing GE requirements for Fall 2019 (for instance) include all requirements effective in Fall 2019, Fall 2018, and Fall 2016.
- Advisors and students can run a What-If report from Student Center to visually see changes to their degree when selecting different requirement terms.
- Effective Fall 2021, Area D7 is no longer included in the Area D requirements and Area F is added (i.e., no student is subject to both requirements)
