The LTWR Dept requests that LTWR 307 Introduction to Argument and Analysis be added as an option for completing the LTWR Minor.

LTWR 307 provides equally important and relevant theoretical grounding in the discipline of LTWR as LTWR 300A and LTWR 300B in order to complete the upper-division coverage requirement.
