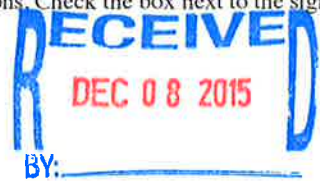

The LTWR Dept requests that LTWR 307 Introduction to Argument and Analysis be added as an option for completing the LTWR Minor.

LTWR 307 provides equally important and relevant theoretical grounding in the discipline of LTWR as LTWR 300A and LTWR 300B in order to complete the upper-division coverage requirement. Adding LTWR 307 will allow students to choose from three different offerings to complete this requirement which will make it easier to facilitate time to graduation. Additionally, 3 course offerings provides more flexibility for students to choose a course best suited for their academic and professional goals when completing the upper-division coverage requirement.
