Catalog Description: Independent research thesis related to an approved public health area. Must work with a faculty advisor for approval of topic and committee development. Prerequisite: advancement to candidacy, approval by Committee Chair.

Writing requirement: The university writing requirement will be fulfilled by the final thesis or paper of graduate project of at least 2500 words.

Student Learning Outcomes:

Students will select a thesis committee by the end of the PH 507 course. The thesis committee requires 3 members (1 chair, 2 members). The research thesis will be individualized for each student in cooperation with their faculty mentors, to address a particular problem in Public Health. As such, the student will be expected to integrate a variety of skills including most, if not all, of the following:

- 1. Refine a proposal for an independent research study (problem, literature review related to the problem, research methodology) and present to selected thesis committee of 3 members (if successful, student will advance to candidacy)
- 2. Complete an application for protection of human subjects if required
- 3. Collect and analyze data for research study and present results to thesis committee

Students will select a project chair by the end of the PH 507 course. The project committee requires 2 members (1 chair, 1 member). The graduate project is designed to expose the student to a broad array of administrative, clinical, and community health care programs within a specific health care organization or public or non-profit agency. As such, the student will be expected to integrate a variety of skills including most, if not all, of the following:

- 1. Refine a proposal for a graduate project and present to selected committee of 2 members (if successful, student will advance to candidacy)
- 2. Analyze a population for health problems
- 3. Investigate health policies related to health problems
- 4. Develop and / or provide health care services to address health problems
- 5. Identify culturally appropriate interventions to address health problems
- 6. Partner with community resources, agencies or individuals to implement health program or project

- 7. Develop a budget and identify sources of revenue to fund public health programs
- 8. Describe evaluation of programs throughout various stages of development and implementation
- 9. Complete project and present findings to project committee

Assignment

- 1. Research Thesis students will complete a 5 chapter thesis paper including introduction, literature review, research methods, findings and discussion.
- 2. Graduate Project students will complete a 5 chapter project paper including introduction to the problem, literature review, methods to complete the project including budget and program evaluation, results of program evaluation and discussion.
