Students explore the intersection of writing, art, photography, new media, and the recent wave of publishing made possible by digital technologies and online printing. Students will be encouraged to experiment with multimedia approaches often employed in contemporary artists books. May not be taken for credit by students who have received credit for VPA 380J and VPA 380-7. May be repeated for a total of six (6) units. Prerequisite: VSAR 302.	Catalog Description: (Not to exceed 80 words; language should conform to catalog copy.
