UCC has reviewed the Minor in Education and has the following requests:

1. Need to submit Revenues and Cost worksheet to Academic Programs **Regina Eisenbach confirmed that we do not need to submit this worksheet in order for UCC to approve this Minor.**
2. Item 12 Catalog Description and the catalog description in the Catalog Copy: 2nd sentence: delete "what and", period after "citizens" / New sentence: "Serves as "**Edits made**
3. Item 12 Catalog Description and the catalog description in the Catalog Copy: Clarification needed regarding Liberal Studies: revisit the word "should" as it makes it sound as if Liberal Studies is the only major that tracks into teaching, and that is not the case. Include in catalog description "who will benefit from taking this minor". **Edits made.**

4. Can LBST students minor in Education? Especially since several courses in this minor are requirements for LBST major. **Yes, and they are encouraged to do so. Is there a place on the forms where UCC would like us to note this?**

5. Did you, or would you consider PHYS 307 as one the elective choices? **We prefer to leave the menu as it currently stands. While it was a challenge to narrow the menu down from the excellent selection that exists at CSUSM, the School of Education spent several months in careful consideration of which courses to include on the menu. We spent significant time discussing the way in which each of the courses informs the others. We already added a course at the request of the CEHHS Curriculum Committee and would prefer not to make any further changes or additions.**
