Hello there Paul,

I checked for a model for this requirement in the 2016-2018 catalog (and I checked earlier catalogs just to be sure). They have never listed the "choose from list" for the similar requirements (before 1800, women and gender, and etc.) The practice has been to list the specific courses on our advising worksheet. We revisit that regularly in the department and with advising.

In talking with Carmen and some others, we all agree it would be best to list it solely on the advising worksheet. Since the Digital History emphasis in courses would shift with faculty expertise and changes (and we anticipate some changes in the next few years), it is possible the "choose from list" would become outdated before the next catalog. It may result in a faculty member without digital training electing to teach a course with no digital history but the student still receiving credit for the digital history emphasis.

This flexibility has worked well for us in the past and allows us to make sure that the requirements have been properly met.

Thanks for the advice on the degree planner.
