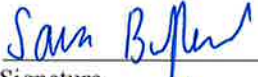
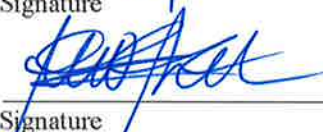

**18. Reason(s) for changing this course:**


The current course prerequisites for Psyc 340 are Psyc 100 (Introduction to Psychology) and 336 (Abnormal Psychology). Psyc 340 covers the field of clinical psychology, including therapy and research techniques, across the lifespan. Psyc 336 covers Abnormal Psychology in adulthood, whereas Psyc 328 (Developmental Psychopathology) covers Abnormal Psychology in childhood and adolescence. Therefore, adding Psyc 328 as a prerequisite option for Psyc 340 in addition to 336 (i.e., changing the prerequisites for Psyc 340 to Psyc 100 and 336 or 328) is appropriate given that the course material in Psyc 336 covers the lifespan. In addition, CHAD students are much more likely to have taken Psyc 328 than Psyc 336: although CHAD students can currently take Psyc 336 for their Cluster C course as a way for them to then take Psyc 340 for their Cluster E course, there are many other course options in Cluster C compared to only two course options in Cluster A in which Psyc 328 falls. Therefore, adding Psyc 328 as another prerequisite option provides another (and perhaps more likely) path for CHAD students to take Psyc 340 as a Cluster E course (please see the attached majors worksheet for clarification regarding Cluster courses in CHAD).. As there are limited Cluster E spots at this time, improving access to these courses will be beneficial for helping the increasingly large number of CHAD students move through the major in a timely manner.

## CHILD AND ADOLESCENT DEVELOPMENT

- Students will be required to verify a clear background check including statewide, county, and federal screening (social security number, fingerprinting) **before** placement in the Center for Children and Families (CHAD 496 Observation and Assessment Lab).
- Students will need to show proof of inactive Tuberculosis, full immunization against Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR), immunization against pertussis and get a flu shot (students may waive the flu shot requirement – see CHAD website: [www.csusm.edu/chad](http://www.csusm.edu/chad)).
- Background checks or additional screening may also be required for students seeking to work with minors in other courses (ex: CHAD 450, PSYC 495, PSYC 499, or EDUC 380/HD380).
