All students admitted to CSUSM as a Business Administration major are initially classified as “Pre-Business” status. The lower-division Pre-Business Core is a prerequisite for “Business Status” and upper-division business courses. The minimum acceptable grade in every Pre-Business and Business course is a C, and a minimum GPA of 2.5 in the lower-division Pre-Business Core. Pre-Business and Business courses may not be taken Credit/No Credit.
