Welcome, and congratulations on your admission to CSU San Marcos! **The fall 2011 semester begins August 29, 2011.** The following information will assist you in preparing to begin your academic career at CSU San Marcos:

### **Financial Aid and Scholarships**

All students are encouraged to submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The priority date for submission is **March 2, 2011**. ### **Immunization Requirements**

The California State University has mandated that students born after January 1, 1957 must demonstrate proof of full immunization to measles and rubella. All first time enrolled students who are 18 years of age or younger on August 1<sup>st</sup> of their entering academic year are required to present proof of full immunization against Hepatitis B prior to their first enrollment.
