

## Liberal Studies Program Review

### Introduction

Liberal Studies is an interdisciplinary degree program. Available options include Elementary Subject Matter Preparation (ESMP) or Integrated Credential Program (ICP) to prepare Liberal Studies students for a teaching credential. Due to the breadth and depth of required courses, this report will focus primarily in the subject areas of Anthropology, Geography, Interdisciplinary Studies, Liberal Studies, and Linguistics. Related areas, such as History and Human Development, will be covered in other program reviews.

The Library supports Liberal Studies curriculum through its instructional programs, research consultation services, collections, circulation, and interlibrary loan services. This report serves as a review of current resources and services. It does not serve as an assessment of the quality of the services or collection.

### Collections

Liberal Studies related materials are primarily located in the Library of Congress call number classifications of G (Geography and Anthropology), H (Social Sciences), J (Political Science), and P (Linguistics). Please note these collection development areas are distributed amongst three librarians: Allison Carr, Social Sciences Librarian; Melanie Chu, Outreach Librarian; and Judith Downie, Humanities Librarian. The following chart details the collection, including both electronic and print volumes, for fiscal year 2006-07. Statistics for 2003-2007 are attached as appendices.

Funds spent toward Liberal Studies collections are informed by faculty recommendations; review of course syllabi and research assignment topics; emerging trends in the literature; the number of students enrolled in programs and classes; and previous circulation activity.

## Government Documents

Since 1994, the Library has been a selective federal depository, collecting about ten percent of government publications available in areas that support the curriculum. State, federal, and local government documents in various print and electronic formats such as US Census, US Geological Survey, and California Department of Education support the Liberal Studies program.

## The Circuit

The San Diego Circuit, a regional consortia of libraries, provides students access to millions of books outside the CSUSM collection. Using the Circuit, students can request materials from University of California San Diego, San Diego State University, University of San Diego, and the San Diego County Library system to be delivered to campus within 24-48 hours. The Circuit is subsidized in part by the CSUSM Library.

## Databases

Increasing full-text database access offers students a range of interdisciplinary journals necessary for research in Liberal Studies. Many subscriptions are provided via California State University system consortium. SFX linking software (a.k.a. "Get It") facilitates easy retrieval of full-text articles when available through other databases or in the Library's collection. The following lists the primary databases<sup>1</sup> that support this program:

JSTOR	Core scholarly journals in geography, anthropology, sociology, political science, and linguistics. From 1838-2002, with no full text for latest 5 years.
Academic Search Premier	Periodicals in nearly every area of academic study. From 1975-current, most full-text.
Sociological Abstracts	Abstracts of international research in theoretical and applied sociology, social science, and political science. From 1963-current.
Sage Journals Online	Includes journals in humanities, social sciences, and sciences. Current full-text.
Blackwell	Journals in social and behavioral sciences and humanities, among other disciplines. Current full-text.
Project Muse	Full-text coverage for hundreds of scholarly journals in the humanities and social sciences. From 1993-current.

Electronic over print sources are collected as appropriate, providing students both on and off campus to thousands of full-text journals, electronic books, cataloged websites, and research guides to support student learning in different courses and subject areas.

## Reserves

The Library provides access to both print and electronic reserve (E-Res) materials for courses. E-Res is password protected for each class, giving students simultaneous access from on and off campus at any time, day or night. The following statistics are for print and electronic reserve materials from Anthropology, Geography, Interdisciplinary Studies, Liberal Studies, and Linguistics classes *combined*, 2003-2007:

In addition to print and electronic reserves, media reserves (DVD, VHS, and CD) are available from the Media Library. Again, due to the interdisciplinary nature of this program, many items placed on reserve are from a broad range of call number areas and therefore may not be accurately represented in these statistics. The following are for media items placed on reserve in Anthropology, Geography, Interdisciplinary Studies, Liberal Studies, and Linguistics classes *combined*, 2003-2007:

## Interlibrary Loan

Interlibrary Loan service provides resources at no cost to students, staff, and faculty for materials unavailable in the CSUSM collection. Average turnaround time is around five days, with copies of articles typically emailed to the requestor and books delivered to the Check Out Desk for pick up. Copyright fees, staff and student assistant time, and related costs of this service are paid for by the CSUSM Library. Frequently requested books and journals are considered for purchase or subscription. The following statistics are for interlibrary loan requests from the Liberal Studies department (not related subject areas), 2003-2007:

It is worth noting that while the Circuit and interlibrary loan services provide students with extensive and relatively quick access to materials, they are no substitute for comprehensive on-site collections.

### Instruction and Research Consultation

Information literacy instruction can be simply characterized as teaching students how to identify, find, evaluate, and cite resources appropriate to their research needs. As with Liberal Studies collections, the abovementioned librarians share responsibility for subject-specific instruction, web-based guides<sup>2</sup> and other instructional materials (e.g. WebCT and MediaSite), and one-on-one research consultation.

For courses that fulfill Liberal Studies degree completion, library-based instruction occurs within classes such as the following:

- § ANTH 200 Cultural Anthropology
- § GEOG 301 World Regional Geography
- § HIS 347 California History
- § ID 340 Diversity and Discrimination
- § ID 370 Border Water Conflicts
- § LBST 307 Children and the Environment
- § LBST 375 Urban Change and Ethnicity
- § LING 480 Field Methods in Linguistics
- § SOC 313 Race and Ethnic Relations

For each class, library faculty work closely and collaboratively with disciplinary faculty to identify relevant learning objectives and resources to best facilitate student learning and research related to the course paper or project. Instruction varies by year and by course, ranging from one 50 or 75 minute class session to multiple sessions scheduled throughout the semester.

As an extension of instruction, one-on-one research consultation is provided in many formats and venues. Students may stop at the Research Help Desk, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Kellogg Library, during all open Library hours, Fall and Spring semesters:

- § Monday -Thursday 7 am - 9pm
- § Friday 8 am- 5pm, and
- § Saturday - Sunday 10 am- 5pm.

Specially trained student assistants answer directional and technological questions, referring research questions to the on-call librarian. Librarians are on-call 52 of the 79 open Library hours. Around-the-clock research support is available via a “24/7” online chat service CSUSM librarians help staff. Students are also encouraged during instruction sessions and at the Research Help Desk to contact subject specialist librarians via email, phone, office hours, appointments, and drop-ins.

### **Collection Capacity**

Over the last five years, the CSUSM Library has spent an average of \$707,595 per year on information resources, while the three California State University campuses closest in size to San Marcos (Bakersfield, Sonoma, and Stanislaus) have spent an average of \$744,008. During that same period, full time equivalent students (FTES) enrollment at San Marcos has increased by 49.6%, while the other three campuses have grown by about twenty percent.<sup>3</sup>

The CSUSM Library has absorbed the costs of supporting most new graduate and undergraduate programs with no additional funding. Furthermore, the Library is experiencing a continuing decline in the total collections budget; increases in book, serial, and database subscription prices; and the addition and expansion of academic programs. The ability to acquire titles to support the Liberal Studies program is impacted by this overall budget picture.
