

## MINOR IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The minor is designed to be supportive of a variety of arts, humanities, and science majors. To declare a minor in Business Administration, students must meet with an advisor in the College of Business Administration (CoBA). Advisors are located in Markstein Hall, Suite 126. To graduate with a minor in Business Administration, students will be required to complete the requirements in effect at the time of declaration.

- Students are considered “Pre-Business” status until they have completed the Pre-Business Core and are changed to “Business” status.
- The Pre-Business Core is a prerequisite for all upper-division CoBA courses and must be completed with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher to qualify for Business Status. Business Status is required in order to register for upper-division business courses.
- The minimum grade for every Pre-Business Core course and upper-division CoBA course must be a “C” or higher or must be repeated.
- Pre-Business Core courses and upper-division CoBA courses may NOT be taken Credit/No Credit.
- Students must submit a Business Status Application to the CoBA Advising Office no later than one week prior to the first day of classes for any given semester.
