

COMMENCEMENT 2009

GRADUATING WITH ACADEMIC HONORS

Graduating with honors, for the purpose of recognition at the commencement ceremonies only, the following applies:

Recognition of academic honors at May commencement ceremonies is based on coursework completed before the semester of the ceremonies, the fall semester. Grades recorded through the fall 2008 semester will be calculated for the overall GPA and the institutional GPA. The lower of these two GPA's will be used to determine academic honor recognition in the commencement printed program. This applies to students graduating in the Fall 2008, Spring 2009 and Summer 2009 semesters.

Enrollment Services Management will provide the list of eligible students which will be sent to me.

Academic Honors are:

Cum laude	3.50 - 3.69
Magna cum laude	3.70 - 3.89
Summa cum laude	3.90 - 4.00

Students who qualify for academic honors recognition will receive an academic honor cord as they check in on the day of commencement, not before and not after. Students do not pay for these cords ~
