REGISTRATION

Registration fee includes tuition, continental breakfast, lunch and workshop materials. Registrations are limited to 30 per workshop and are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations are accepted through July 12th, however, College Board* materials cannot be guaranteed for any registrations occurring after July 1st. Call regarding space availability after July 1st. PURCHASE ORDERS

An approved school purchase order is due at the time of registration. A registration form for each student must be submitted with the purchase order. School districts may substitute participants. All substitutions must be submitted in writing by Monday, July 12th.

An optional two (2) units of academic credit (non-degree applicable) are available for full attendance of the Institute at an additional fee of \$160 plus a \$12 transcript fee.
