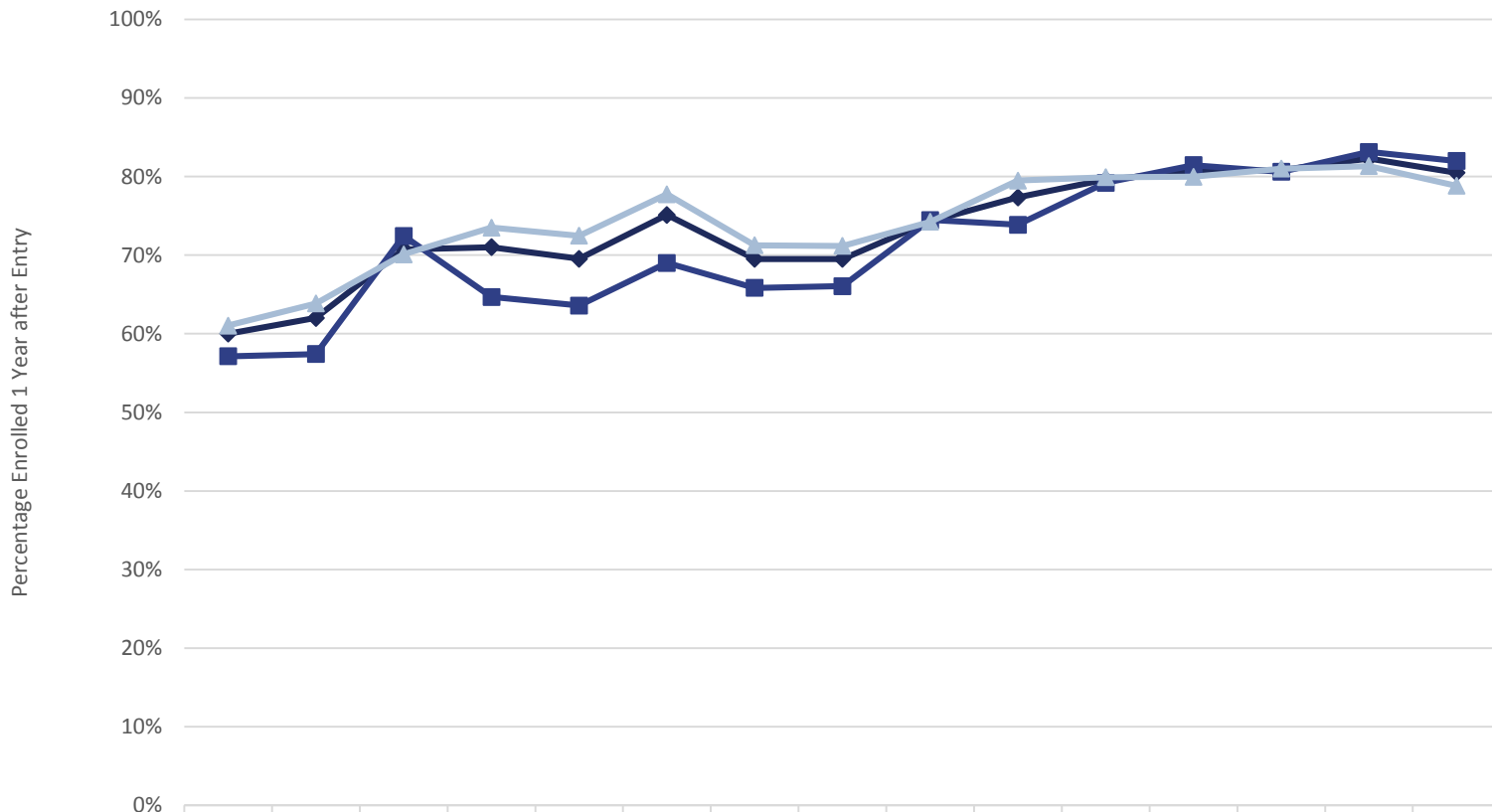

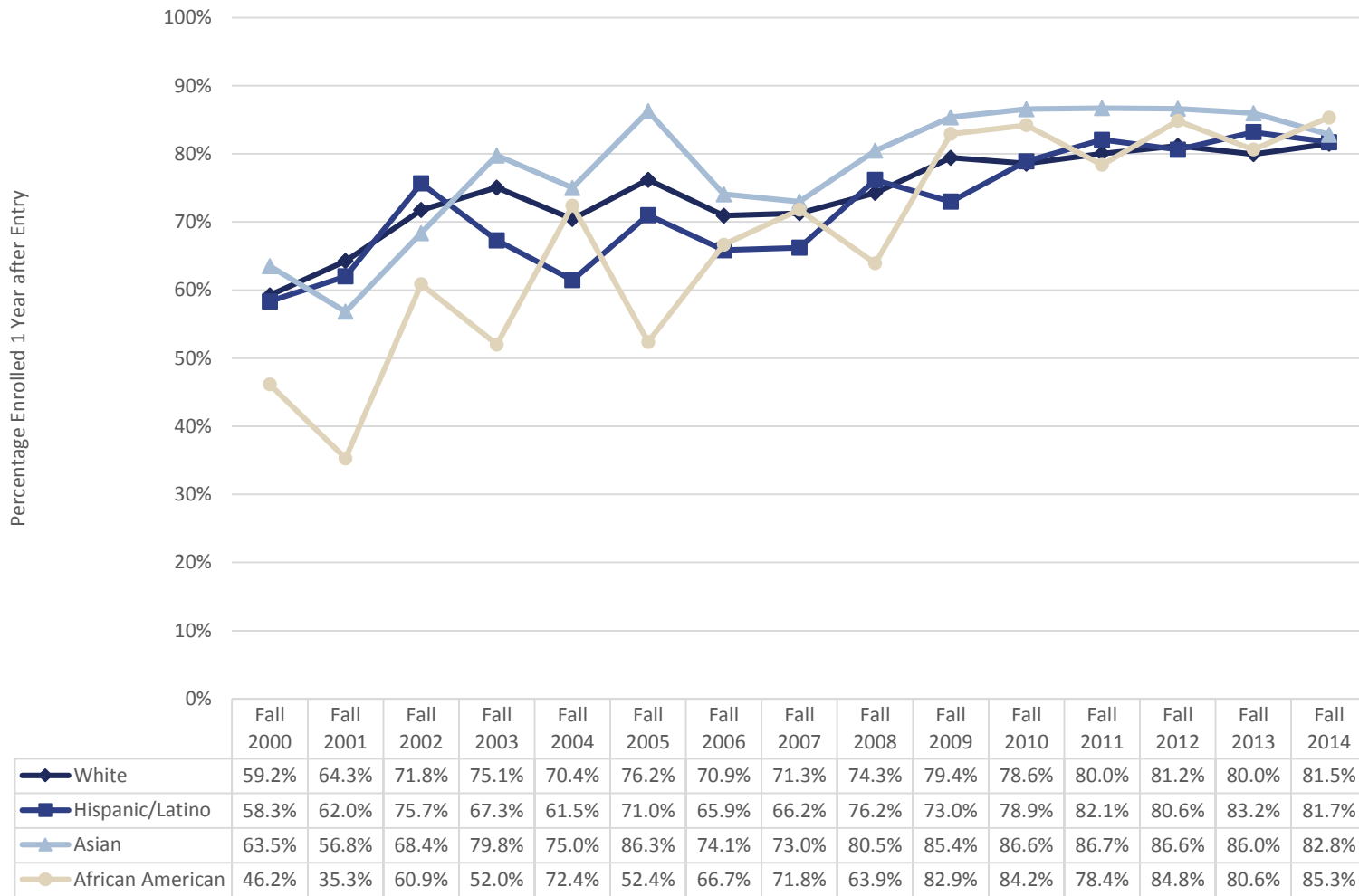

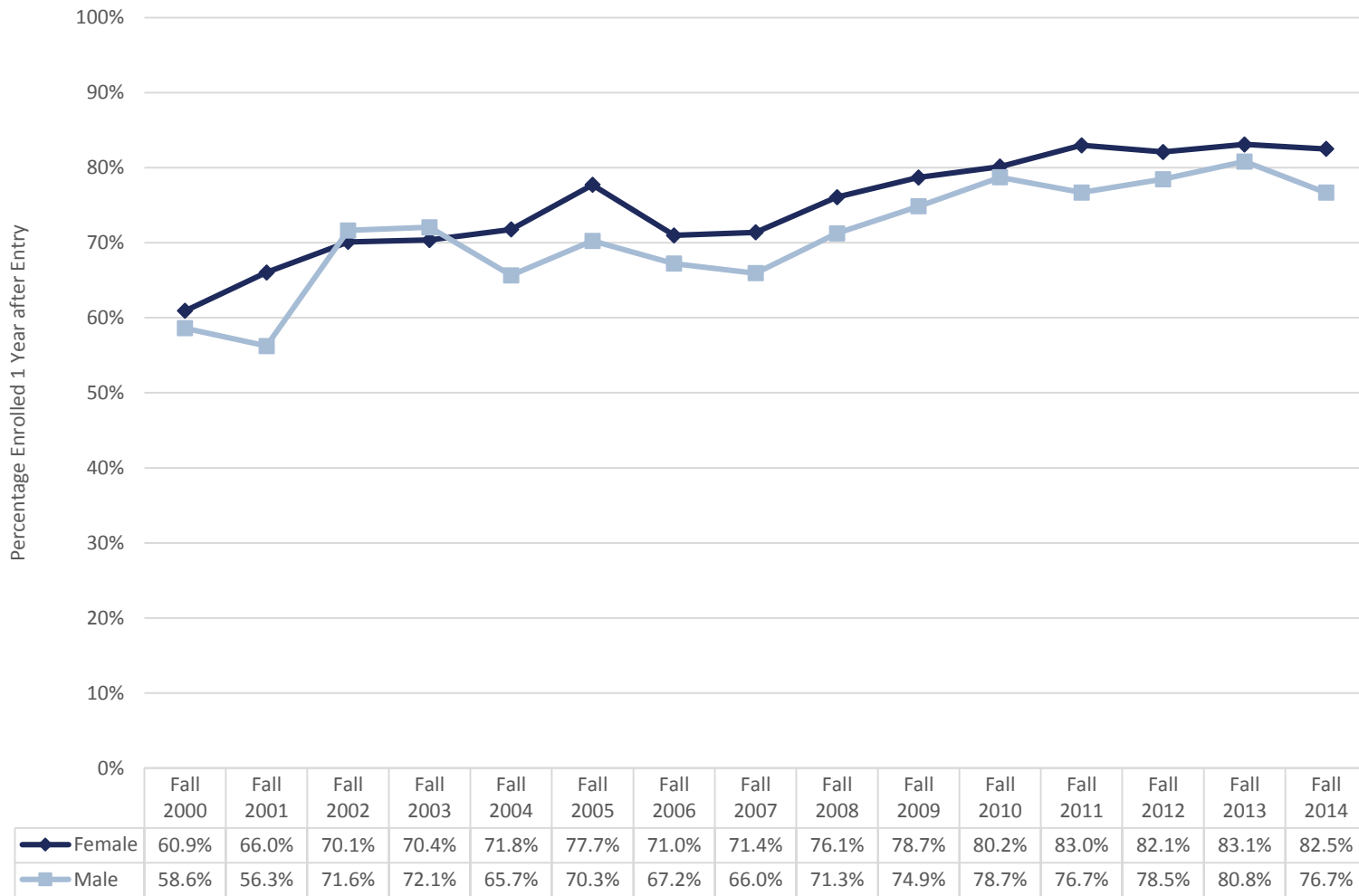

### 1-Year Continuation Rates by Race/Ethnicity & Entry Term First-time Freshman Students



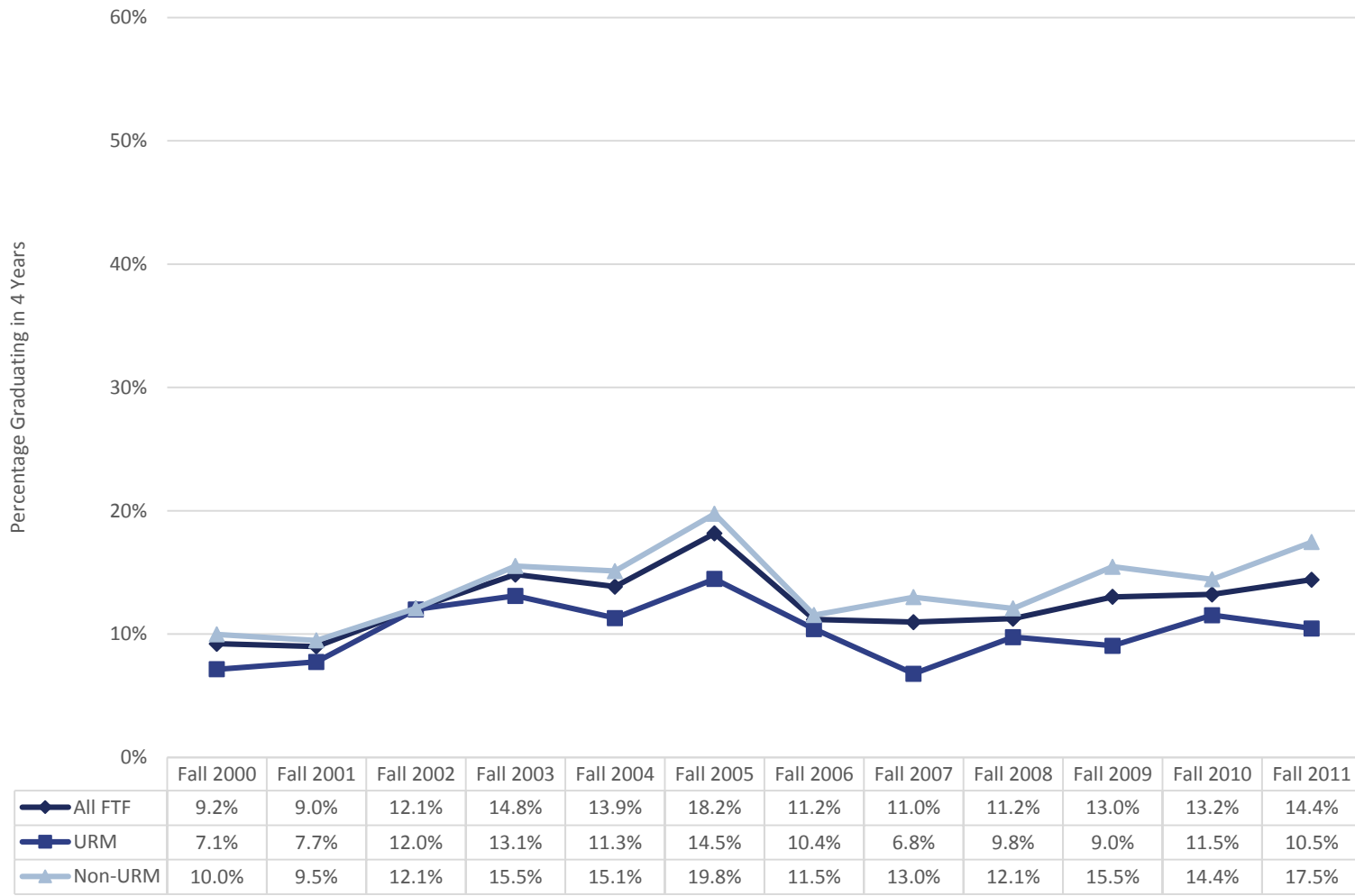

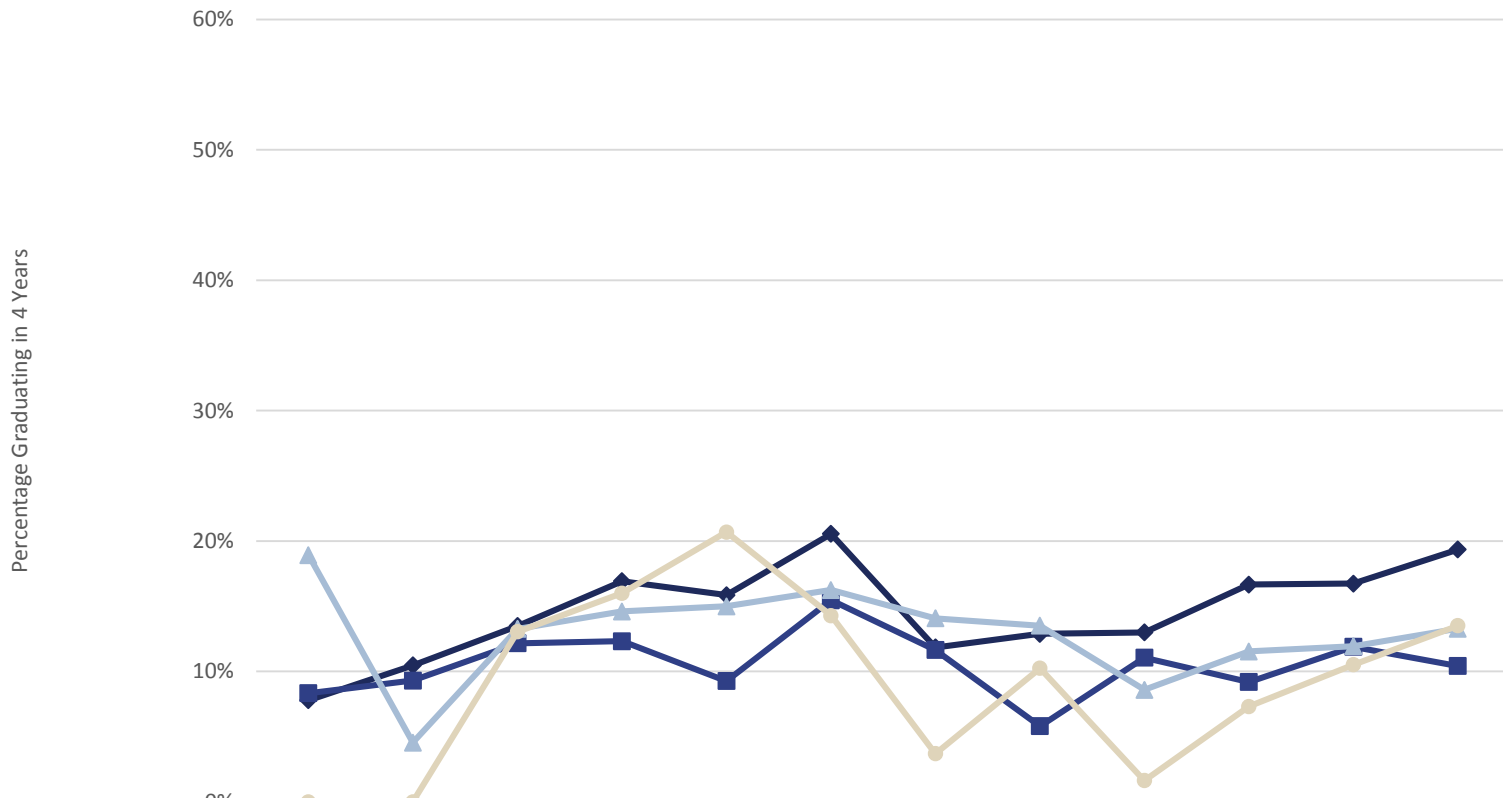
### 4-Year Graduation Rates by Underrepresented Minority Status & Entry Term First-time Freshman Students

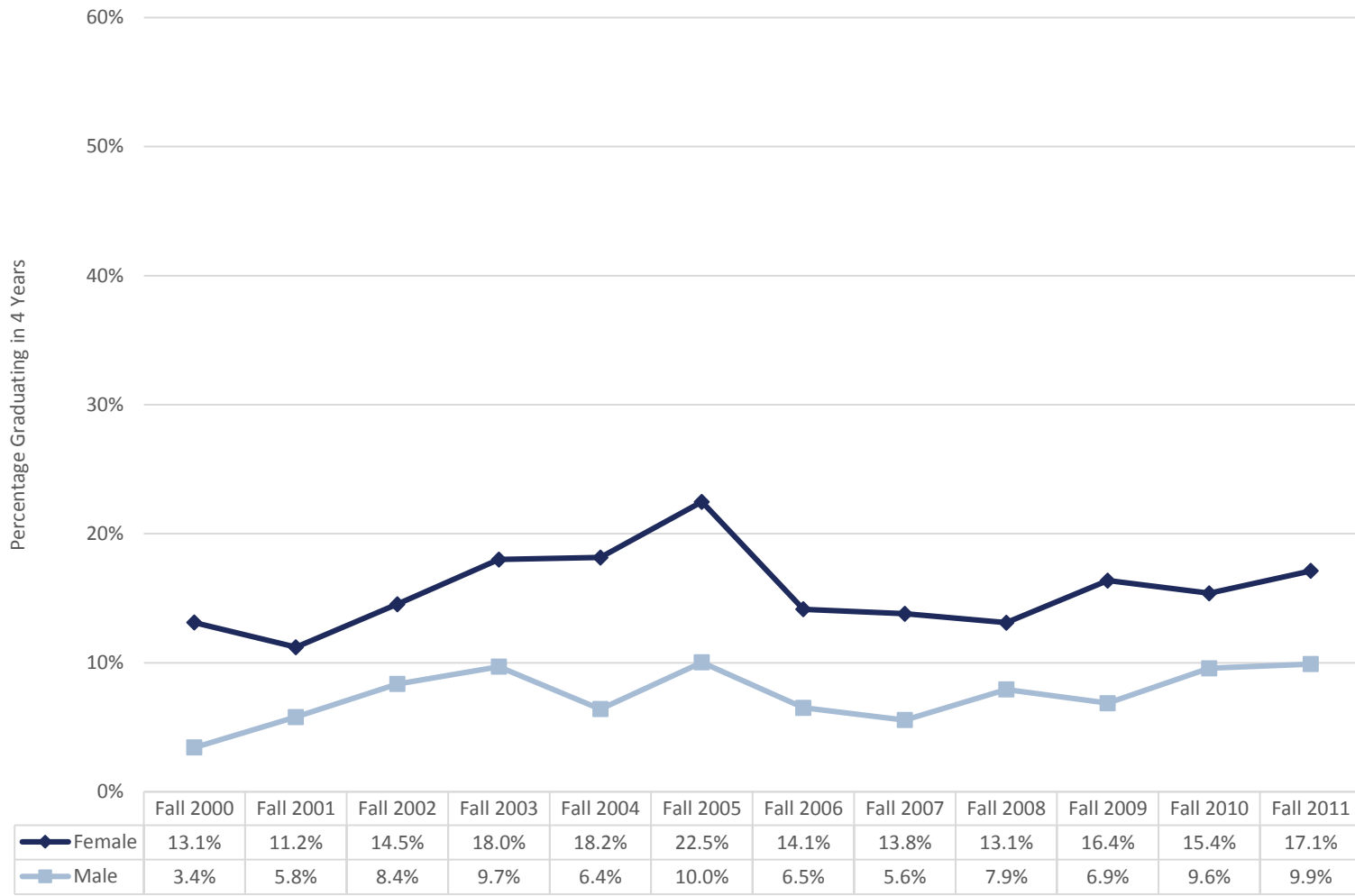

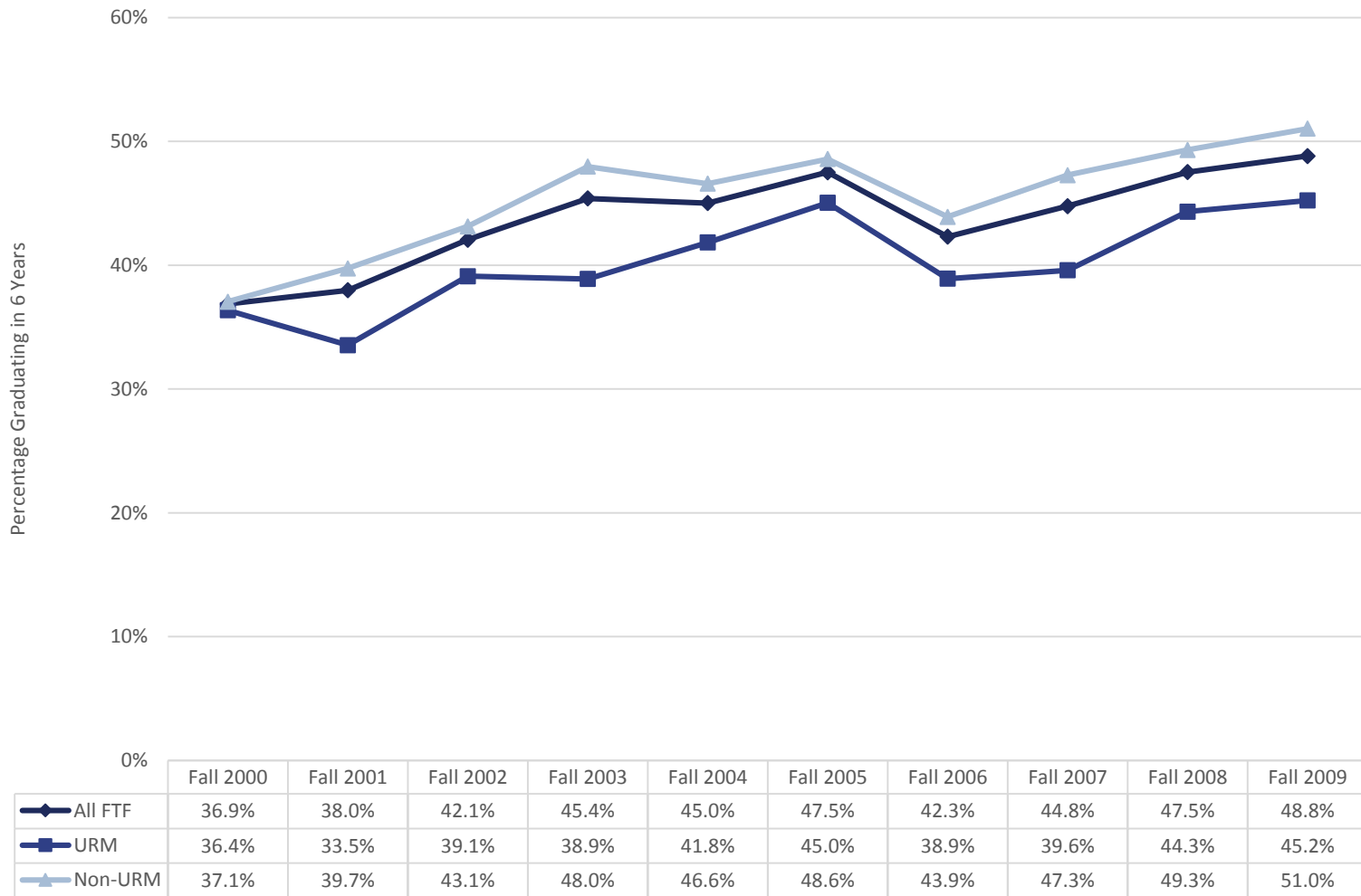

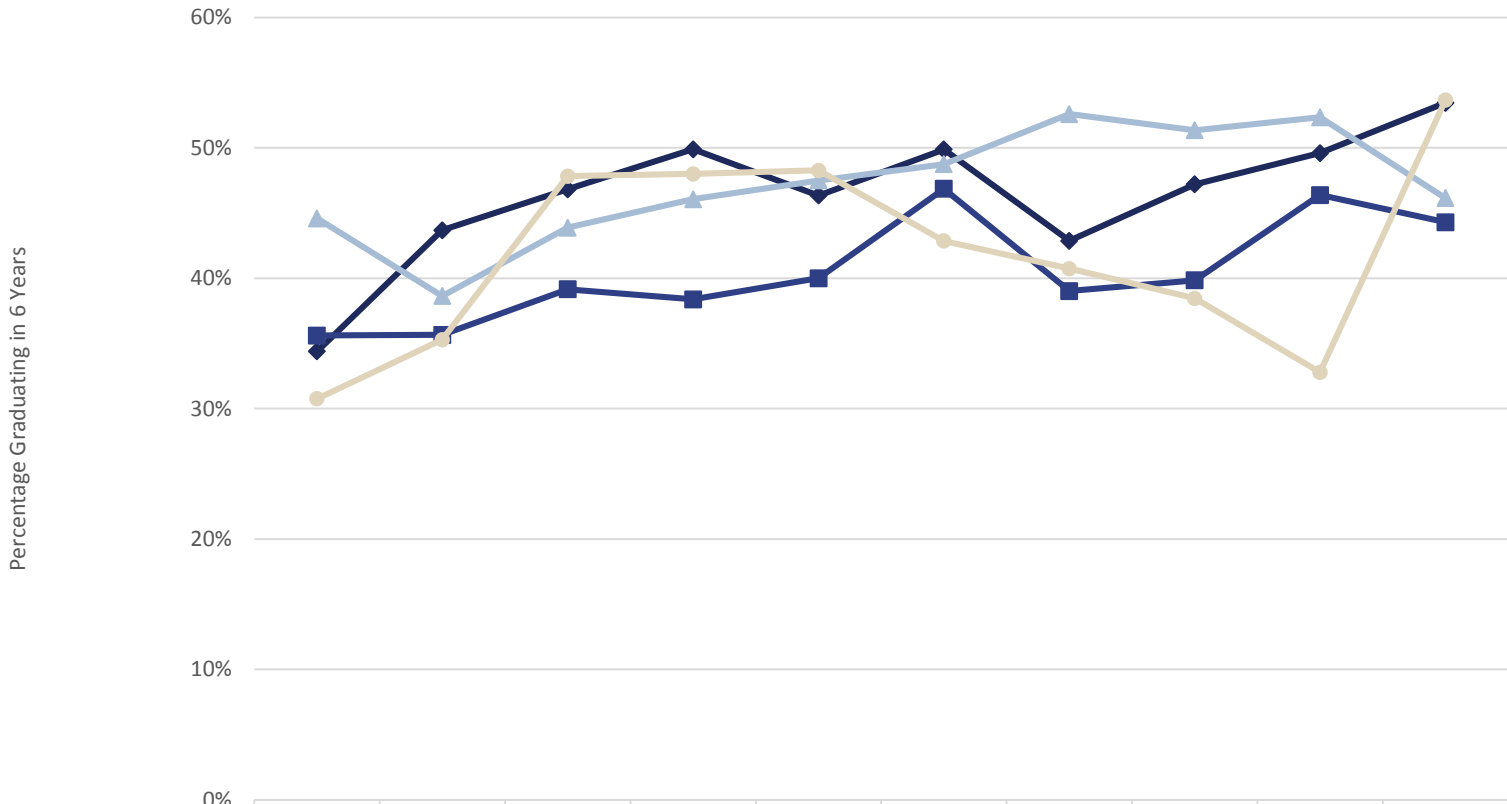
### 6-Year Graduation Rates by Underrepresented Minority Status & Entry Term First-time Freshman Students

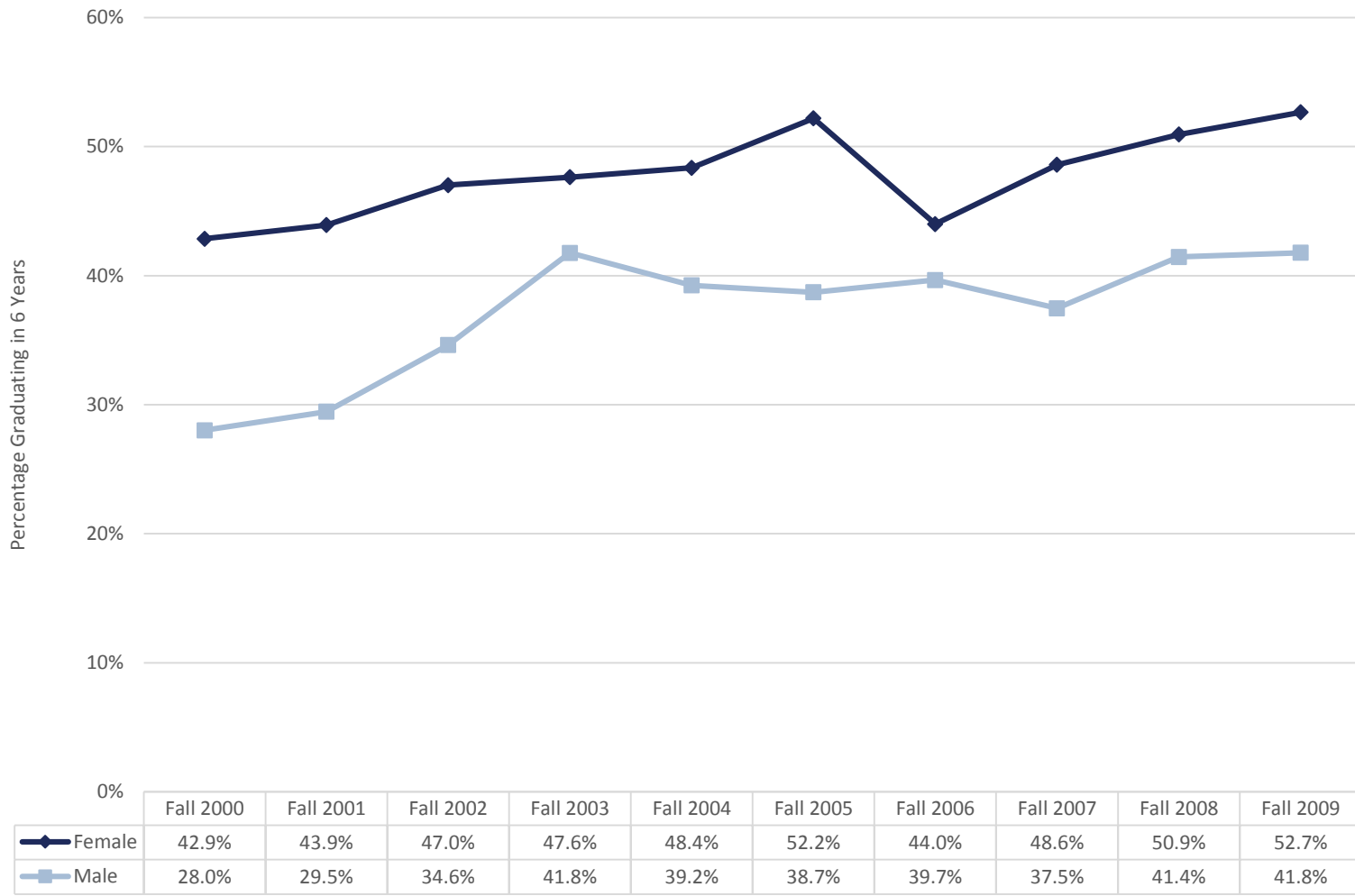

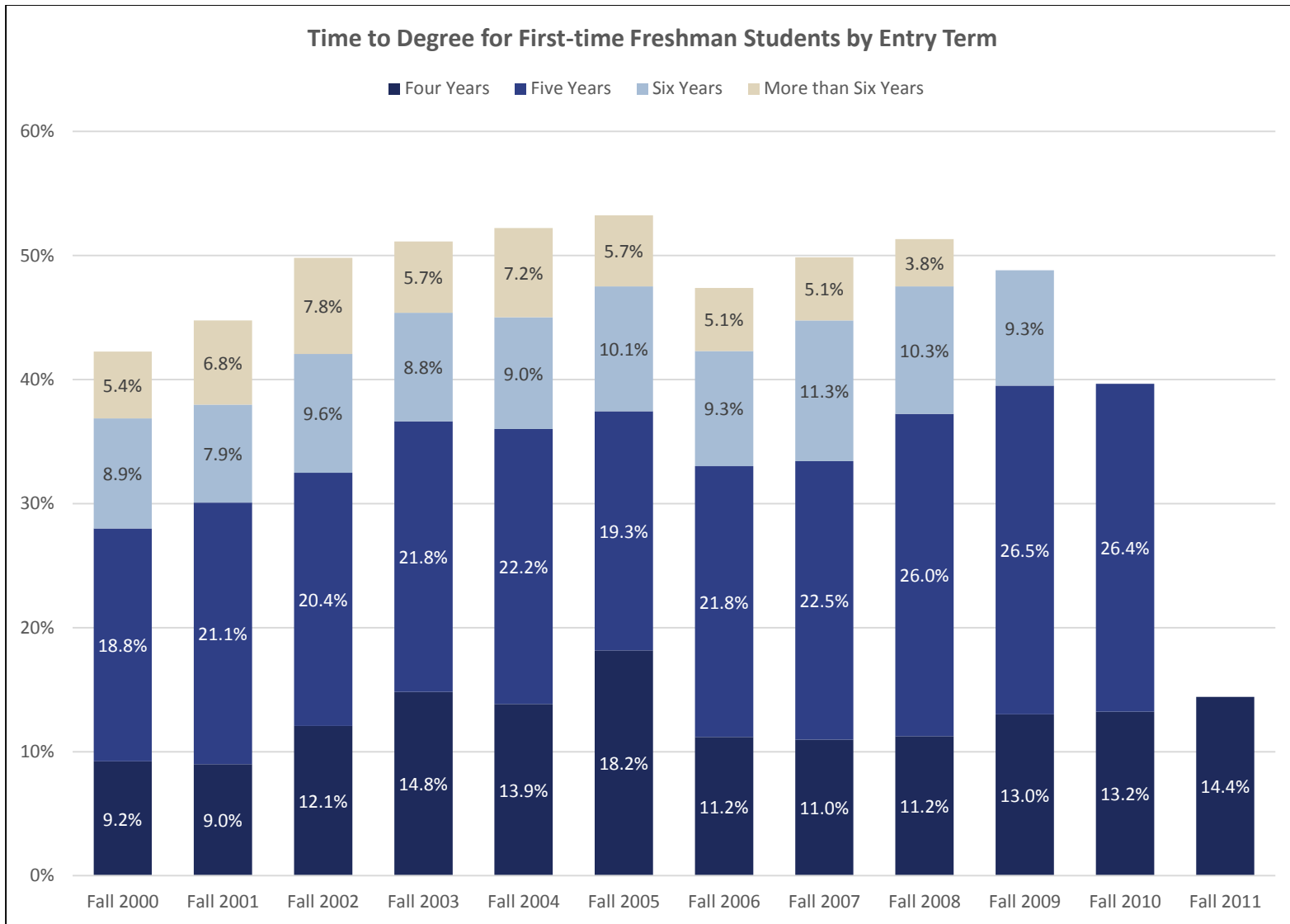
