
Learning Community Breakout Report

2023 CSUSM HIPs Survey

In Spring 2023, California State University San Marcos licensed the <u>HIP Quality</u> topical module from the National Survey of Student Engagement and administered the survey to all degree-seeking undergraduate students. 1,465 students responded, for a total response rate of 11.8%. Below are results specific to those who indicated they had participated in or were participating in a **Learning Community**, using the following definition: *Students take two or more linked courses as a group and work closely with one another and with their professors. Many learning communities explore a common topic and/or common readings through the lenses of different disciplines (AAC&U).*


Which of the following have you done while in college at CSUSM or do you plan to do before you graduate?











About how long have you been participating in it?











About how many hours did [do] you spend in a typical 7-day week on this Learning Community experience?





Compared to your typical learning experiences at this institution, about how much effort did [does] this experience require?

















To what extent did [do] these meetings focus on what you were [are] learning in this experience?








