
Study Abroad Breakout Report

2023 CSUSM HIPs Survey


In Spring 2023, California State University San Marcos licensed the <u>HIP Quality</u> topical module from the National Survey of Student Engagement and administered the survey to all degree-seeking undergraduate students. 1,465 students responded, for a total response rate of 11.8%. Below are results specific to those who indicated they had participated in or were participating in **Study Abroad**, using the following definition: *The study abroad program allows students to attend lectures or conduct research at foreign universities for a semester or academic year while earning credits toward graduation*.



















About how many hours did [do] you spend in a typical 7-day week on the Study Abroad experience?





Compared to your typical learning experiences at this institution, about how much effort did [does] Study Abroad require?









As part of this experience, about how often did [do] you interact with people from a different background or identity (racial/ethnic, economic, political, religious, etc.)?
















