

## Typing Accents on a PC (in any program)

These accent codes should work on any IBM-compatible PC.

1. Hit "number lock" (located on the 10-key number pad on the right side of the keyboard)
2. Hold down the "Alt" key.
3. Type in the codes below using the 10-key number pad on the right side of the keyboard.
4. Release the "Alt" key, and the letter or symbol will appear.
