IACUC Standard Operating Procedure – #1 Reporting of New Animals on Campus

Effective Date: June 21, 2021

A. Purpose

To establish a standardize procedure for reporting new animals on campus.

B. Background Information:

CSUSM animal use areas are spread throughout campus and there is currently no centralized animal care technician that monitors animal use protocols and procedures. Therefore, IACUC must implement a standardized process to ensure the University is in compliance with federal rules and regulations.

CSUSM animal users obtain animals from a variety of sources throughout the year. To ensure IACUC is aware of vertebrate animal research activities on campus a process to report newly arrived animals will be established.

C. Procedure:

- 1. Animal Users/Principle Investigators (PIs) must notify IACUC once animals have arrived on campus. This notification must take place within 5 business days of animals arriving on campus.
- 2. PIs must email the CSUSM IACUC indicating new animals have arrived on campus. Please put "REPORTING NEW ANIMALS ON CAMPUS" in the subject line of the email.
- 3. The email must include the following information:
 - protocol associated with the newly arrived animals
 - the total number of animals that have arrived on campus
 - the total number of animals used to date
 - the total number of animals approved in a 3-yr period for that protocol
- 4. IACUC will have a member of the committee inspect the animal facility to confirm the number of animals that have arrived on campus and the protocol associated with those animals.
- 5. Research activities must not be initiated prior to the IACUC inspection.
- 6. Failure to report newly arrived animals may result in disciplinary action that could restrict animal use activities.
