- Sample Research Agreements are posted on the CUGR Teams
 - o Protect faculty and student interests.
 - Raw data is not copywrite-able. Faculty are encouraged to have students complete a research/RSCA agreement, so they know expectations for data and dissemination (i.e. students do not take your data/research and publish/present elsewhere. Examples of bad outcomes on Retraction Watch).
 - Also helps to protect intellectual property.
 - Carmen happy to work with any faculty who would like to have alternative examples. Elinne brought up the example of agreements/acknowledgments for course-based undergraduate research experiences (CUREs) and publications that may arise from data generated in these courses.
- External funders often have data management guidelines—there are related resources on the library's website. DMP tool included, and information about repositories.

- CSUSM has some agreements with some journals for open access (e.g., Elsevier, etc.) for faculty publications.
- ORCID: Library, etc. trying to get more people signed up for ORCID. Info on library website—faculty grad students, undergrads.
 - o Open Researcher and Contributor ID as a unique identifier for you!
 - o https://libguides.csusm.edu/ScholarlyCommunication/Orcid
 - Universities may use to track scholarly output, but this is an opt-in feature.
- Library can make article available via ScholarWorks. Let them know if you're interested in this.
