#### 5. Sigma Xi at CSUSM

The chair introduced and turned over the meeting to Maya Qaddourah, a third year CSUSM Biochemistry student. Qaddourah explained the benefits of establishing a chapter of this <u>Scientific Research Honor Society</u> at CSUSM and reported steps that are currently in progress towards this goal, including Student Leadership & Involvement Center's (SLIC) approval of Sigma Xi as a recognized student organization. Ten current Sigma Xi members within the county are required to support establishing a chapter at CSUSM. Dr. lafe was recognized as a member and offered support as

a faculty advisor if needed. Dr lafe explained the nomination process and discussion on where this organization should be centered ensued.

Oaddourah reported a letter of recommendation from the Dean of OGSR, along with a three-year plan for proposed activities, and advertising/promotion to students and faculty will be needed. Students will be required to pay a 1x initiation fee of \$20 plus \$40 in annual dues. Sources of financial support were discussed.

## 6. Giving Day and CUGR fund prioritization

- **a.** Giving Day is the Tuesday after Thanksgiving. Everyone is encouraged to share on social media.
- **b.** Prioritizing distribution of Giving Day funds was discussed. The committee agreed to allocate \$1000.00 at the 2024 Student Poster Showcase for student awards.
