The purpose of this message is to inform members of the campus community that **Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE) is no longer a recognized fraternity at CSU San Marcos**. This means that the TKE fraternity is not part of the CSUSM Greek community. Because Student Life & Leadership is aware of some mis-information floating among students, my goal is to clarify this situation.

Over the next several days and weeks, you will encounter many opportunities to get involved on campus. Should you decide to take part in Fraternity Rush or Sorority Recruitment, there are five recognized Greek organizations at CSU San Marcos:

Women's Sororities:

Alpha Pi Sigma
Alpha Chi Omega
Alpha Xi Delta

Greek life has many things to offer and the department of Student Life & Leadership advises our five chapters in their promotion of leadership development, scholarship, community service and lifelong friendship.

As you become acquainted with the campus, you may learn of Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE). **This fraternity is no longer officially recognized by CSUSM**. Student members of Tau Kappa Epsilon may approach you to join their chapter or simply invite you to attend events off campus. Because TKE has lost its university recognition, they are no longer advised by campus personnel, and TKE events are wholly independent of CSU San Marcos. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the status of Tau Kappa Epsilon so you can make a fully informed decision about your participation.
