Welcome! Tukwut Leadership Circle is open to all students enrolled at CSUSM. The program takes approximately 25 hours to complete, and you must complete the program within 2 years.

Upon meeting the program requirements, you will earn a certificate in leadership.

Pre-Assessment:

You fill out a brief assessment upon registering for the program, in Student Life & Leadership.

Workshops:

The program requires you to attend a total of 10 workshops: 1 from each of the Seven C's plus 3 additional Tukwut Leadership Circle workshops of your choice.

Campus Engagement:

You must complete 6 hours of campus engagement. You need to submit a description of your project(s) to Student Life & Leadership. Examples of the campus engagement activity include: planning a campus program, being an active member of a student organization, participating in a Cougar Recreation event or sport, or writing for the campus newspaper. You will be writing about this experience in your reflection paper.

Civic Engagement:

You must complete 6 hours of civic engagement. You need to submit a description of your project(s) to Student Life & Leadership. Examples include: tutoring, participating in a community clean up, running errands for home-bound elderly, participating in CSUSM Alternative Spring Break, San Marcos VIBE, or delivering meals to HIV patients. For more opportunities, contact the ASI Community Service Specialist at (760) 750-4990. You will be writing about this experience in your reflection paper.

Reflection Paper:

This program component should be completed near the end of your participation in the program. You will respond to the following prompt. Responses must be typed (12 pt font/double-spaced) and 2-3 pages in length. Include your name and student ID number for tracking purposes.

- Reflect on the 7 C's of leadership and how the Social Change model of leadership has influenced your leadership journey. Provide specific examples from your campus engagement activity and civic engagement project.
- How do you define leadership?
- What are 2-3 specific leadership goals you have as a result of participating in the Tukwut Leadership Circle?

Leadership Transition Interview:

As the final component, you will schedule a personal interview with a staff member from Student Life & Leadership. Your reflection paper will provide a foundation for the conversation.

Post-Assessment:
