The TUKWUT LEADERSHIP CIRCLE is open to any enrolled CSUSM student and is based on the Social Change Model of Leadership and "the Seven C's." The Seven C's include:

Consciousness of Self
Congruence
Commitment
Collaboration
Common Purpose
Controversy with Civility
& Citizenship

To complete the program, students must:

- Attend a total of 10 workshops (1 from each of the 7 C's categories plus 3 additional workshops)
- Participate in approved civic & campus engagement projects
- Write a short leadership reflection paper
- Participate in an exit interview to develop a personal leadership plan. **E-mail Shannon Nolan at snolan@csusm.edu to**

schedule your exit interview and submit your reflection paper or to ask any questions that you may have about the TLC.

Upon completing the program, students will receive a leadership medal and a certificate of leadership.
