

Attention all registered students for fall 2009

Per the CSU Board of Trustees action on July 21, effective in fall 2009, the State University Fee has been increased. Your reassessed fees are now posted to your account. The table below reflects the updated fees.

FALL 2009 FEE PAYMENT DEADLINES

If you reserved courses and paid the current fall fees on or before **July 9, 2009**, the additional fee increase approved by the Board of Trustees is **due August 31st at noon**.

The deadline to pay current fall fees for classes reserved on or after July 9, 2009, through August 5, 2009, is **noon on August 6, 2009, and** the additional fee increase approved by the Board of Trustees is **due August 31st at noon.**

For classes reserved on or after **August 6, 2009**, payment is **DUE THE FOLLOWING BUSINESS DAY BY 12 NOON, and** the additional fee increase approved by the Board of Trustees is **due August 31st at noon.**

If you would like to sign up for the tuition payment plan, please log on to www.tuitionpayenroll.com and let our office know when you sign up so a fee deferment may be placed immediately.

Students who would like to authorize access to their financial account by their parent(s) to enable the parent(s) to make payments to the student's account online, will need to go to www.csusm.edu/sfs and click on "pay your fees" for further instructions.

If you are dropped from your classes due to non-payment, you may not be able to add all of your classes due to capacity being met and/or the 13-unit maximum allowed per student for fall 2009.

In light of the increasing cost of attendance, we would also like to advise you to consider applying for financial assistance if you have not already applied. The Financial Aid and Scholarships office wants to assure students and their families that students will continue to have access to financial aid. Although many of the priority deadlines for 2009–2010 have passed, funding is still available through federal aid programs but we advise you to complete the application process as soon as possible. The standard "Free Application for Federal Student Aid" FAFSA form is available online at the www.fafsa.ed.gov website. CSUSM's school code number is 030113.
