These skills can be acquired either through participation in performance ensembles in high school or through private study. Accordingly, knowledge of music fundamentals and the ability to read standard music notation is also expected. Students without these skills can complete remedial work at the area community colleges to obtain them.

- All non-articulated courses MUST be reviewed and approved by a faculty advisor.
