Hi Laurie – I hope this message finds you well.
I am writing with regard to the UCCs review of the MA in Reading, Language, and Literacy - Option Elevation Proposal. The committee would appreciate clarification on the following listed below.

1. On page 3 & 13 - UCC suggests adding the title of the master's program above list of core coursework- **added**
2. On page 4 & 14 - UCC suggests deleting section on "The Culminating Experience" as this is redundant - **deleted**
3. On page 16: the paragraph above "Curriculum" header that states, - **deleted**
"The process to establish the stand-alone program is not known by any of the participants in the current process, and thus the level of commitment can't be compared to that of the current proposal. The current proposal does include this master's degree being additionally offered through Extended Learning in an online format, which will broaden the interest and enrollment of the program."

Please clarify / UCC could not understand what this paragraph meant and whether it was necessary to include within this form.

4. On page 16-17 - please confirm correct course titles listed on both sides of this table. For example, EDUC 610 is listed on the page 16 as Reading and writing research, when in fact that is not the correct course title. Same for EDUC 618, 619, 622, 698.
Additionally, you will need to submit C2s for any course title changes that take place between MA in education: Option-Literacy and the elevated MA in Reading, Language, and Literacy (if no course title changes will occur upon the option elevation then both sides of the table should have the same course titles. **No course titles have changed (I flashed back to an earlier version of our master's option, but all those course changes were approved by Senate 3 or 4 years ago). These have been corrected.**
