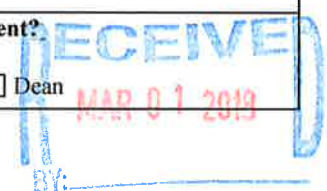

Dear Kim,

As you know, Jodie and I have been working since last semester on requesting a department name change. Instead of WMST, we are requesting the new name to be WGSS (Women's, Gender and Sexuality Studies). In order to make that

request, we had to change all the courses in the WMST catalog and all the abbreviations to reflect the new name. Some courses remained exactly the same (except for the abbreviation) but others saw slight modifications in order to add gender and sexuality content.

I am seeking your support for two courses that affect LBST. Jodie and I neglected to include LBST in two C2 Forms for WGSS 301 (Gender and Sexuality in Contemporary Societies) and WGSS 303 (Education, Gender and Race)- I am attaching the original C2-Forms for both courses that we submitted to CAPC; CAPC added your department to the list; this is what CAPC is asking:
