- Students with a Global Studies minor MUST declare their geographic area and global issue by submitting the [Global Studies Declaration Form](#).
- Approved courses for the Global Studies minor are located on the [Global Studies Course Matrix](#).
- Seventeen units must be upper-division.
- Courses used to satisfy the geographic area may not also be used to satisfy the global issue area.
