ADMISSION TO THE MAJOR

- Entering freshman are expected to be proficient on piano, voice, or an orchestral/band instrument. These skills can be acquired either through participation in performance ensembles in high school or through private study. Accordingly, knowledge of music fundamentals and the ability to read standard music notation is also expected. Students without these skills can complete coursework at either local (Palomar, Mira Costa) or regional community colleges as their core music curriculum complements CSUSM.
- Students entering at the junior level must have completed the lower-division core coursework before pursuing upper-division coursework at CSUSM. Contact the Music Department Chair for additional information regarding performance proficiencies and/or coursework.
