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**Students report feeling more connected to the CSUSM campus because ACE Scholars Services has helped them to build a sense of belonging and community within the university. Former foster students have met other students with similar experiences through meetings and events hosted or sponsored by ACE Scholars Services. Students reported that it is a positive experience to be able to relate to other students on campus.**

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## SUMMARY: QUESTION 32

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**Overall, ACE Scholars Services provides a unique support community for former foster youth. According to the majority of students, ACE is a “great program” that provides a “support system on campus” that is helping students to get “through difficult patches.” The staff members listen to what students have to say with understanding and provide the support services and resources students need in order to make it to graduation.**

**QUESTION 33. What is the least favorite part of being an ACE scholar? (Open ended)**

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**SUMMARY: QUESTION 33**

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**When asked what about the least favorite aspects of being an ACE scholar, students mentioned a few things: lack of sensitivity towards wanting to be private about being a former foster youth; numerous emails about events that may not be that relevant to their needs; staff could increase level of knowledge about academic requirements such as units needed to graduate; and findings ways to overcome the stigma associated with being a former foster youth.**
