TIMEFRAME: 30-45 minutes

## SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 8.5” x 11” White Paper
- 1 Dark or Bold Color Marker (for outlines)
- Assorted Markers

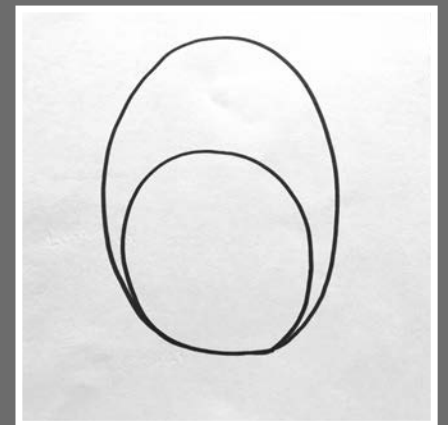
## VALUES:

In the center of the page, begin by drawing an eye (realistic, cartoon, google eye, etc.) using either a pencil or marker. Make it as big as you can. Feel free to use a cup or other object as a stencil if you would like or refer to a picture, character, anime, etc.

Add details! Consider adding shading, eyelashes, starbursts, outlines, etc. Feel free to refine your lines and play with thick and thin lines in your work.
