





However, I was provided with supporting documents (auditor's responsibility, scope of the audit, and timing of the audit, current year developments, and risk factors of ASI) that stated ASI's auditing firm, Aldrich CPAs, has engaged to audit the financial statements of ASI for the year ended June 30, 2023 and prepare Form 990.
