| 08 Information | CSU Tuition Increase Update Description: Update on the CSU Tuition increase proposal following Board of Trustees meeting. Fiscal Impact: None Ernest reviewed Board of Trustees (BOT) vote to approve tuition increase, which was approved at their last meeting with at 15-5 approval vote. He also reviewed process for increasing tuition by 6% each year until 28/29 when the plan will sunset and be assessed. Justin reviewed the advocacy efforts that took place including CSSA opposition stance, efforts on Cal Grant Reform, and open forum time at BOT meeting. Ernest also reviewed what funding is also meant to support including GI 2025 for basic needs and mental health as well as Title IX operations, salaries, and infrastructure. Zeenia had questions about financial aid and presenters mentioned need for changes to financial aid eligibility to serve the 40% Natalie had questions about fees, and it was clarified this increase is separate from the WRF fee proposal. Jesus wanted further clarification on what the increase is meant to support. 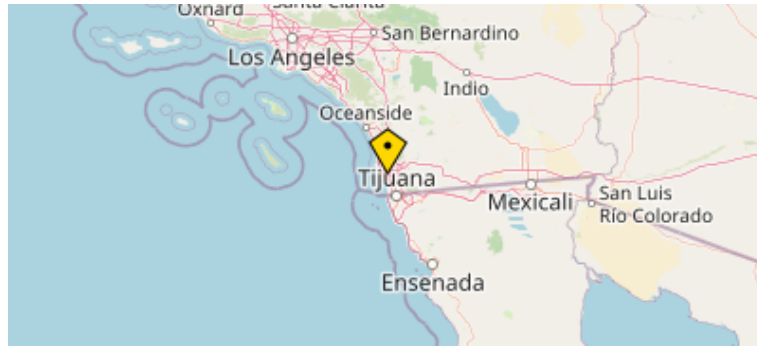

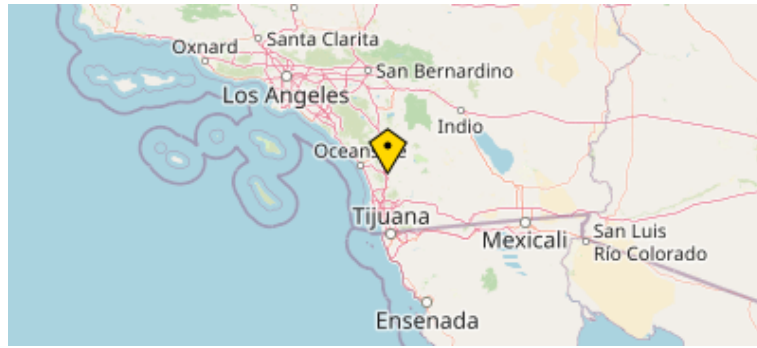

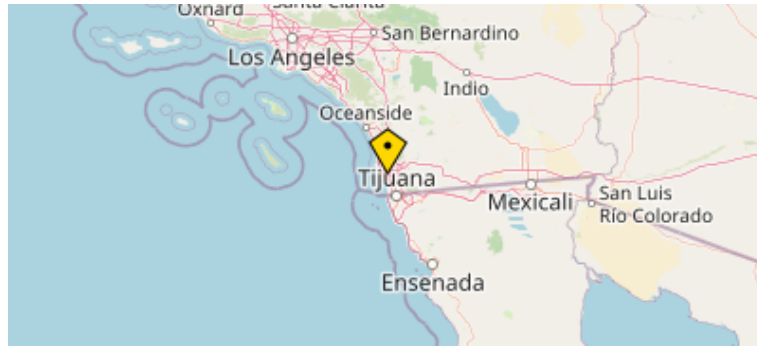
