

COVID-19 Placement Guideline Recommendations for Students

Although most internship/service learning placements will currently be held remotely, COVID-19 guidelines are recommended for both “on site” and remote/virtual activities to allow for any meetings, events, or community-based activities a student may still need to participate in as part of their responsibilities.



Please review the guidelines below:

- ◆ Practice social distancing measures.
- ◆ Wear a face cover as needed.
- ◆ Check that any safety equipment, protective gear, or other equipment/tools provided to you by the organization has been disinfected.
- ◆ Know where cleaning products are stored.
- ◆ Disinfect your work area frequently.
- ◆ Wash hands frequently.
- ◆ Know procedures for calling in sick. If you are sick, contact your site supervisor and faculty immediately and do not go to your placement site.
- ◆ Pay attention to any other COVID 19 related protocol that may be in place at your placement site, including but not limited to:
 - ◆ how to limit exposure within placement activities
 - ◆ use of and access to any necessary protective equipment
 - ◆ required symptom checks
 - ◆ procedures for calling in sick
