*UDGE GUIDELINES:

- Courses used to satisfy the UDGE, MUST be certified as UDGE.
- UDGE must be taken after you have completed 60 units.
- If you take a course for an UDGE course PRIOR to completion of 60 units, it WILL NOT count to clear the UDGE requirement.
- Courses may NOT double count towards both the major and UDGE (unless otherwise noted).
- UDGE may NOT be in the same discipline (subject) as your major.
- UDGE courses are subject to change. Please check the current class schedule for UDGE certified courses each semester.

HOW TO SEARCH THE CLASS SCHEDULE FOR UDGE COURSES:

On the Class Search screen in your Student Center:

- Click the small green "**Additional Search Criteria**" arrow.
- Under the "**Course Attribute**" drop-down menu, select "**General Education Requirements**"
- Under the "**Course Attribute Value**" drop-down menu, select the GE category you would like to search (example: LDGE A2 Written Communication).
- Click the green "**Search**" button.
