



**2020 Community Champion Award

The 2020 Community Champion Award is an annual recognition of a graduating student who is earning a Bachelor's Degree and has demonstrated outstanding achievements in service to the campus and/or greater community during their tenure at California State University San Marcos. This honor is bestowed upon one undergraduate student each academic year who is graduating with a degree from the College and has made a significant contribution to our institution's mission of community engagement and service. The Dean, working with the college faculty, will select a student to be recognized with this honor at the CHABSS Academic Honors Celebration.

Award Process:

1. Nominations due **Monday, February 10, 2020**. Nominations may be submitted to the Dean's Office in person at SBSB 4115 or via email to lmelena@csusm.edu.
2. The CHABSS Dean will review nominations and select the student awardee.
3. The CHABSS Dean's Office will notify all nominees, including the student awardee and their nominating faculty.

Criteria

- Completion of Bachelor's Degree from College in Fall 2019, Spring 2020, or Summer 2020
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75

Completed Nomination Packets must include the following:

- A faculty recommendation supporting the nominee's achievements in advancing College's commitment to inclusive excellence, equity, and social justice.
- A resume that includes a history of community involvement efforts, in addition to academic, service, and leadership history.
- A personal statement from the nominee regarding the significance of their contribution and service to the community.
