



**2020 Scholarship and Creative Works Champion
College of Humanities, Arts, Behavioral & Social Sciences**

The 2020 Scholarship and Creative Works Champion Award is an annual recognition of a graduating student who is earning a Bachelor's Degree and has demonstrated outstanding achievements in research and/or creative works during their tenure at California State University San Marcos. This honor is bestowed upon one undergraduate student each academic year who is graduating with a degree from the College. The Dean, working with the college faculty, will select a student to be recognized with this honor at the CHABSS Academic Honors Celebration.

Award Process:

1. Nominations due by **Monday, February 10, 2020**. Nominations may be submitted to the Dean's Office in person at SBSB 4115 or via email to lmelena@csusm.edu.
2. The CHABSS Dean will review nominations and select the student awardee.
3. The CHABSS Dean's Office will notify all nominees, including the student awardee and their nominating faculty.

Criteria:

- Completion of Bachelor's Degree from College in Fall 2019, Spring 2020, or Summer 2020.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75.

Completed Nomination Packets must include the following:

- Faculty recommendation supporting achievement in scholarship and/or creative works
- Resume to include history of research and/or creative works within academic field. Examples include, but are not limited to:
 - oral or poster
 - translating into other languages or media
 - artistic presentations, performances, recitals, or exhibits
 - films, videos, or other media projects
 - refereed publications
 - published book chapters, books, music, scripts, poetry
- Personal statement from the nominee regarding the significance of research and/or creative works and as it relates to the attainment of a college degree, generally, and in their major, specifically.
