



**2021 Inclusive Excellence Champion Award

The 2021 Inclusive Excellence Champion Award is an annual recognition of a graduating student who is earning a CHABSS bachelor's degree and has demonstrated outstanding achievements in advancing the College's commitment to inclusive excellence, equity, and social justice during their tenure at California State University San Marcos. This honor is bestowed upon one undergraduate student each academic year who is graduating with a degree from the College.

Award Process:

1. Nominations due by **Monday, March 15**. Nominations may be submitted to the Dean's Office via email to lmelena@csusm.edu.
2. The CHABSS Student Academic Success Taskforce will review nominations and provide a recommendation to the Dean. The Dean will make the final selection.
3. The CHABSS Dean's Office will notify all nominees, including the student awardee and their nominating faculty.

Criteria:

- Completion of a CHABSS bachelor's degree from College in Fall 2020, Spring 2021, or Summer 2021.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75.

Completed Nomination Packets must include the following:

- A faculty recommendation supporting the nominee's achievements in advancing the College's commitment to inclusive excellence, equity, and social justice.
- A resume that includes a history of inclusive excellence, equity, and social justice efforts, in addition to academic, service, and leadership history.
- A personal statement from the nominee regarding the significance of their efforts in the areas of inclusive excellence, equity, and social justice.
