I. Convening of the Regular Meeting

Van Metre took a roll call. A quorum being present, Chair Schreiber called the meeting to order at 4:04 pm.

II. Open Session

Schreiber opened the meeting to public comments. There were none.

III. Minutes of the Sept 29, 2022, Annual & Regular Meeting

Schreiber asked if everyone had the chance to review the minutes distributed prior to the meeting and called for corrections. *No corrections were offered; the Sept 29, 2022, minutes were approved as distributed.*

IV. Committee Reports and University Updates

a. University Update

Villarreal shared that the university was ranked number one on the Social Mobility Index through College net and that it has received a four-year, three-million-dollar grant to cover childcare fees to assist with offsetting fees for student parents. Also, she noted additional recognitions of and awards to President Neufeldt, Ben Cherry, and Diana Diaz (Rising Star) in the San Diego Business Journal.

b. Corporation Update

Marchese provided staffing updates on Dorothy Davis, Maria Chiem, and Travis Douglas joining the team and the relocation of the Office of Sponsored Projects and Human Resource suites for operational purposes.

Marchese shared about the C3X-NACAS conference and the innovations and technologies takeaways that he and Janelle learned on student feedback in the Dining

and Housing programs. Marchese also reported on the ABC licensing for beer and wine integration within the concessions and catering programs.

Lastly, Will mentioned the partnering with graduate studies on the technology transfer program. Will turned the meeting over to De Leone who provided background on the tech transfer policy governing intellectual property and the steps the Corporation would take in vetting protection and licensing via patents.

c. Sponsored Projects Committee update

De Leone briefed on the proposal and award reports ending September 30, 2022 (Attachment C & D) De Leone shared the FY 22-23 Q1 Sponsored Projects and Proposals data.

d. Executive Committee Update

Wyden reported the Committee has no new reporting items and the next committee meeting is scheduled for February 6th.

e. Finance & Operations Committee Update

Rene highlighted the success of Campus Café. Shared that the tax exemption is pending, and the committee is in support of the unbudgeted expense associated with the service of beer and wine.

f. Joint Audit Committee Update

Schreiber reported on behalf of Thibodeau that the Joint Audit Committee met on September 28, 2022, and there is nothing to report at this time.

g. Student and Housing Dining

Walsh reported the next meeting is scheduled for November 28, 2022, and there is no new reporting items.
