



Dear CSUSM Community,

In continued service to our region, we are proud to share that CSUSM will host a County of San Diego-operated COVID Vaccination Super Station, likely beginning Sunday, Jan. 31. While we are providing campus space, all operations will be managed by the County of San Diego, including cleaning and sanitization.

The site will be located at the Sports Center and Clarke Field House with free parking provided in Parking Structure 1 on levels 2 and 3 and disabled parking in Lot L next to the Sports Center. Vaccines will be available to those in [eligible phases/tiers](#) by appointment only. No walk ups will be accepted.

In conjunction with the opening of the vaccination site on campus, **the hours of operation will change for the COVID testing center at CSUSM beginning Friday, Jan. 29. The new hours will be from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday through Thursday (closed Fridays and Saturdays beginning this week).** Testing remains free at the Viasat Engineering Pavilion on a first-come, first-served basis.
