On April 3, I provided you with an update on our efforts to develop temporary changes to policies this semester. Since then, Academic Senate unanimously approved a resolution which outlines temporary changes to academic policies for the Spring 2020 semester, and President Neufeldt and I have fully endorsed it. These temporary changes cover grading options, including Credit/No Credit grading, course withdrawals, academic probation and disqualification and course repeats.

In the coming days, you will receive an email communication with details and guidance on what these changes mean and how to access the options available to you. In addition, we will be providing our faculty and staff with resources that can help them guide you through these options.

We know that this semester is a challenging one in many ways, and I am deeply grateful for your continued patience as we work through these policies.
