

FORGIVABLE LOAN

This forgivable loan is available only for Kaiser employees interested in the RN to BSN program or MSN program.

- Forgivable Loan Amounts:
 - •RN to BSN: of up to \$5,000
 - MSN: up to \$10,000
 - Post-MSN: up to \$10,000
- 13% Tuition Discount from CSUSM

WHAT IS A FORGIVABLE LOAN?

In general, a forgivable loan allows you to borrow money without having to pay it back provided you meet the loan criteria. To have the IONE loan forgiven, students must:

- *Maintain continuous enrollment;
- *Maintain a GPA of 3.00 or higher throughout the program; and
- *Commit/agree to work for Kaiser for two years after completion of the program.

- Meets program admission criteria
- Agrees to work for Kaiser for two years after completion of the program

SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is available only for nurses in Southern California County Hospitals interested in the RN to BSN program. Kaiser employees are not eligible for this scholarship. *See website for specific hospitals

ELIGIBILITY

- Cumulative 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- Meets program admission criteria
- · Must maintain continuous enrollment
- Agrees to work for a county hospital for two years after completion of the program
