Financial Aid Season Is Here

What does that mean? It means that, starting Oct. 1, you could:

- Complete the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) or the [California Dream Act financial aid application](#). The sooner that these are completed and submitted, the sooner the financial aid office can provide an award estimate.
- Encourage your student to start the CSUSM scholarship application. It only takes about 20 minutes to complete and it applies to a variety of scholarships available to CSUSM students.

Get those applications submitted as soon as possible!
