## Reflections: The Bridge between Service & Learning

The Summer Teaching Institute will introduce faculty to the frameworks for reflection, as well as how reflections may provide that bridge between service and learning. Faculty will be shown how to assess reflections and the types of reflections. We invite faculty to participate regardless of their experience with service learning. Faculty are welcome whether they are just beginning to think about service learning or whether they have incorporated it into several courses.

The Summer Teaching Institute will focus on both the pedagogy and the practice of service learning and on reflection. This includes:

- Outline learning objectives that emphasize the benefits of service learning
- Find a service that fits the needs of your course and engages students
- Designing reflection activities tied with the learning objectives and the service
- Examining reflection and other assessments key to student learning
- Examining resources on reflection
