Fall 2021 Course Modality Options	Detailed Description
Face-to-Face (F2F)	Format: This is the traditional method of on campus course delivery, with instructors and students present in the classroom. Classroom capacities will be reduced as necessary to comply with safety guidelines.
Hybrid (<u>Hyb</u>)	Format: This format combines F2F with virtual learning. Students and faculty will meet face to face on scheduled days and engage in virtual learning on non-campus days. The virtual component can be scheduled either synchronously (same day/time schedule as on campus meeting) or asynchronously. All synchronous components must be built into the schedule, whether on campus or virtual. Classroom capacities will be reduced as necessary to comply with safety guidelines.
Online (<u>OnL</u>)	Format: This course format is delivered entirely online via one of three modalities: <i>Synchronous:</i> Instructor and students attend class sessions together online at regularly scheduled meeting dates and times. <i>Asynchronous:</i> Course content is presented entirely online, and students work on their own schedule to meet class assignment deadlines. Instructor and students do not come together at the same time. <i>Blended:</i> Combination of synchronous and asynchronous course delivery. All synchronous components must be built into schedule.
Live and Online (L&O)	Format: This is a F2F course with one group of students in the classroom and the other group streaming the class sessions live (i.e., synchronously). The size of the on-campus group will depend upon room capacity as set per safety guidelines and could change if safety guidelines change.
