Spend your summer studying in Chiang Mai, a city that blends a modernizing country with traditional Thai culture, and gain an understanding of Thailand's past, present and future.

- Choose from a 3-week program (3 credits) or a 7-week program (6 credits). Students that stay for 7 weeks can also take Thai language for an additional 3 credits (9 credits total).
- Study on campus, surrounded by local students, while also experiencing course content brought to life through included program field excursions.
- Live off campus in modern apartments a 5-minute walk from campus.
- Learn more about the fascinating histories, belief systems, cultures and issues impacting Southeast Asia through a variety of available courses.
- Benefit from access to TEAN's Chiang Mai Resident Director and other in-country staff for continued support throughout the summer.



ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

- TEAN students are hosted by the Institute of Southeast Asian Affairs (ISEAA) that is based at Chiang Mai University. ISEAA offers courses on the history, culture and society of Thailand and Southeast Asia. The ISEAA courses are transcribed by Portland State University (PSU).
- Chiang Mai University (CMU) was founded in 1964 as northern Thailand's first institution of higher education and is now home to approximately 36,000 students. The university is ranked by Thailand as 3rd in the country for academics, 5th for research output, and is the number one university outside of Bangkok.

*Students that enroll in the Public Health course will be charged an additional \$300 due to the additional field trip costs for this course.

**Students that enroll in two sessions plus take the Thai Language 1 course will be charged an additional \$650 for the language course tuition.
